Who we are



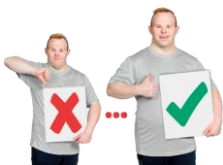
Association for Real Change (ARC) is a charity that works in Northern Ireland.

TILII TV programmes look at the ideas, wishes and feelings of people with a learning disability.

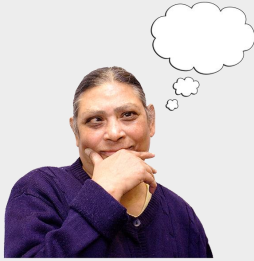
We
