Positive Behaviour Support Service

Positive Behaviour Support is a person centred model of support that aims to increase understanding and reduce distressed behaviour.

We work with Service Users, their families and staff through assessment, developing Positive Behaviour Support Plans and offering practice led support.

We strive for capable environments, encourage individual choice and self-advocacy, increase skills, support active participation thus improving quality of life and reducing distressed behaviour.

The Positive Behaviour Support Service Team worked with Greg Nixon, a Service User form Derry/Londonderry and his Social Work Team.


Greg's care team Potens (NIDCA) recently won the National Learning Disability and Autism Award (NI) for 'Breaking down barriers'.

Hospital Sensory Rooms

The Sensory Room in Altnagelvin Hospital Emergency Department has been used by 751 patients since opening in March 2022.

This success has led to the developmet and opening of a Sensory Room in the South West Acute Hospital in June 2023. The new Sensory Room will be officially opened in October 2023.

Both Sensory Room have received positive feedback both from Service Users, Carers and our Staff.

Annagh Social Farm

Annagh Social Farm CIC supports people with a learning disability to actively participate in seasonal purposeful farm, horticultural and conservation activities on farms in Fermanagh and Tyrone.

This year Annagh Social Farm CIC welcomed the summer season. Service Users have been collecting eggs from the hens and ducks and have welcomed new calves. Service Users also do a butterfly walk, identifying and recording the butterflies they see.

Recently we made and decorated window boxes that are now blooming with flowers.

The sun has also ripened the fruit maze that Service Users pick as they wander around. Soon the peaches will be ripe in the greenhouse and smoothies can be made with all the delicious fruits in the workshops and outdoor classroom.

Involvement Update



Adult Learning Disability Services continue to have a focus on involvement.

Through the Local Involvment Group (LIG) and Strategic Involvement Group (SIG), there were concerns expressed that the process was no longer working and so Hummingbird (NI) completed an evaluation of the work in 2022. The evaluation concluded that involvement successfully promoted change however the Involvement Model needs to evolve.

The Local Engagement Partnership is a partnership of a wide range of stakeholders including representatives from statutory agencies, community, voluntary and independent sectors working together to improve services for adults with a learning disability.

The evaluation recognises the potential strengths of this Model to offer a jointly led forum who work collaboratively with Service Users and Carers, sharing ideas and opportunities to improve access to and experience of Adult Learning Disability Services.

The Trust have endorsed this approach and a Facilitator will be recruited to support the ongoing development of this important work.

Lilliput and Stage Beyond Launch Hi-Vis Summer Festival

Stage Beyond and Lilliput have announced details of an exciting new 'Hi-Vis' summer festival of music and dance starring adults with learning disabilities which will be held at The Playhouse in Derry from July 17th-21st 2023.



The week-long festival will include lunchtime concerts from 12:30 - 1pm on Monday to Thursday (July 17th-20th) performed in The Playhouse by the Quartet: Conor Linehan (Piano), Ken Edge (Sax and Clarinet), Oonagh Keogh (Violin), and Mary Curran (French Horn).

A festival finale showcasing the collaborative creative talents of Stage Beyond and Lilliput participants will be free for members of the public to attend at lunchtime on Friday, July 21st at 1:30PM in The Playhouse.

Staff Raise Funds for Sensory Room

In January ten members of staff (Social Workers, Team Leader, Family Support Worker, Behaviour Support and Occupational Therapist) signed up to run as part of relay teams in the Belfast Marathon.

The staff decided to raise money for the Sensory Room in the South West Acute Hospital. The team have raised a total of £13,000.


"Hello my name is Paul and I attend the Satellite Unit, Strabane.
