
Adult Learning Disability Online Hub

We work with Service Users, their families and staff through assessment, developing Positive Behaviour Support Plans and offering practice led support.


We strive for capable environments, encourage individual choice and self-advocacy, increase skills, support active participation thus improving quality of life and reducing distressed behaviour.

The Positive Behaviour Support Service Team worked with Greg Nixon, a Service User form Derry/Londonderry and his Social Work Team.

Greg's care team Potens (NIDCA) recently won the National Learning Disability and Autism Award (NI) for 'Breaking down barriers'.

Lisa Finlay, Behaviour Therapist, explained:

"Since moving to his supported living placement Greg has made some great achievements which at a time were very difficult for him."







Hospital Sensory RoomsThe Sensory Room in Altnagelvin Emergemcy Department has been used by 751 patients since opening in March 2022.

Following this success a Sensory Room has opened since June in the South West Acute Hospital and will be officialy opened in October 2023.

Both Sensory Rooms have received good feedback from Service Users, Carers and Staff.

Involvement Update

Adult Learning Disability Services continue to have a focus on involvement. An evaluation of the Local and Strategic Involvement Groups was completed by Hummingbird (NI) in 2022. The evaluation concluded that the Involvement Model needs to evolve.

The Local Engagement Partnership is a partnership of representatives from statutory agencies, community, voluntary and independent sectors working together with Service Users and Carers to improve services for adults with a learning disability. The Trust will be recruit a Facilitator to support this important work.

Lilliput and Stage Beyond Launch Hi-Vis Festival

Stage Beyond and Lilliput is hosting a 'Hi-Vis' summer festival of music and dance starring adults with learning disabilities at The Playhouse in Derry from 17th-21st July 2023.



There will be concerts from 12:30 - 1pm on Monday to Thursday (July 17th-20th) performed in The Playhouse by the Quartet: Conor Linehan (Piano), Ken Edge (Sax and Clarinet), Oonagh Keogh (Violin), and Mary Curran (French Horn).

A free festival finale showcasing the talents of Stage Beyond and Lilliput participants will be on Friday, July 21st at 1:30PM in The Playhouse.

"Hello my name is Paul and I attend the Satellite Unit, Strabane.


I attend a pottery class through the North West Regional College and have enrolled to complete an OCN qualification in pottery.
