Introduction

Nomination Criteria:

- Any individual member of staff who has worked in Health and Social Care for 25 years or more.
- Should the individual be retiring or planning to retire shortly. The individual should be in active employment by the Western Trust on the launch date of the Awards (Monday 13 November 2023).
- Please nominate an individual who you consider demonstrates the Trust's Mission 'Caring Together – Committed to Better'
- Please provide examples on why you believe this individual is creating a legacy within the Trust.

Entries will be assessed on the following:

- Does the nominee's work reflect one or more of the HSC values Working Together, Compassion, Excellence, and Openness & Honesty?
- Does this person act as a role model in the workplace?
- Do they demonstrate commitment to and passion for their role, going the "extra mile" showing a "can do" positive attitude
- Please illustrate how they have made contributions to care OR to working conditions to support patients or their colleagues?

Any member of staff can nominate an individual staff member or team. Nominees must be employed by the Western Trust at the closing date of nomination. An individual can make multiple nominations but cannot nominate the same person or team more than once.
