Who's Eligible for PrEP?

- Gay/bisexual men
- Trans women
- People who are having condomless sex with people living with HIV, who are **NOT** on treatment
- There may be other risks that mean that people may benefit from PrEP, if you think this is the case we are happy to talk it through at the sexual health clinic.

Do GPs Need to do Anything?

No, patients can self-refer to the clinic. This is the easiest and quickest way to access PrEP.

There may be occasions where patients request to see their GP for tests whilst taking PrEP if they cannot attend our clinic for example a urine and blood test.
